Description

Chilean Australis Hake, or Merluccius australis, is a wild-caught fishery sourced from the pristine and unspoiled waters of Chilean Patagonia. This remote and virgin region provides an ideal environment for the hake, which features a slender body, a short head, and a protruding lower jaw with visible teeth. While the fish can grow up to 160 cm in length, individuals between 60 cm and 100 cm are more commonly encountered.
