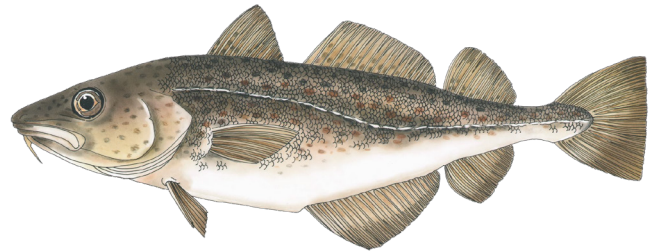

Description




The Chilean seabass fishery in Chile is managed by the Undersecretariat of Fisheries and Aquaculture (Subsecretaría de Pesca y Acuicultura), with guidance from scientific and management committees. The Chilean seabass, a deep-water species fished at around 2000 meters, is found in the cold waters of the southeastern hemisphere, particularly around Antarctica. This highly sought-after fish is prized for its large flakes, buttery texture, and clean flavor.
