Jack Mackerel, an amazing fish

The Jack Mackerel, or *Trachurus murphyi*, is a pelagic fish that lives in the cold waters of the South Pacific Ocean, along the coast of Chile. The fish has a life span of approximately 15 years, reaching maturity at age of 3 when it has grown to a size of 26 centimeters. It swims in dense schools at depths of 10 to 150 meters, following a clear route that runs from Chile to Oceania and back.



Recognized and certified excellence

As a result of our commitment to the environment, the Jack Mackerel fishery has received major certifications, such as IFFO-RS and MSC. Both agencies certify that the fishery is sustainable, responsible, causes minimal environmental impact and is properly managed based on ongoing audits and constant updates.



Environmental friendly fishery

The status of Jack Mackerel conservation is monitored and governed by SPRFMO, an inter-governmental agency committed to the sustainable long-term conservation of fisheries in the South Pacific Ocean and to safeguard the ecosystem where the diverse species live.



Best Quality tested daily by the Humboldt Current

Every day it confronts the powerful Humboldt Current, one of most productive marine ecosystems in the world, providing excellent nutrients required for its growth and reproduction. The Current raises those nutrients from the ocean depths, creating an abundant primary production (such as microalgae) and secondary production (namely krill), major sources of nitrate, sulfate and phosphate, to name a few.



From the largest Ocean in the World

Jack Mackerel live in the cold waters of the Pacific Ocean, the largest ocean in the world, covering 33% of the planet's surface.



Orizon S.A., the main player of Jack Mackerel industry in the world is a leader in quality products. Why Orizon leads the world in Jack Mackerel?

The Jack Mackerel fishery status is classified as in Full Exploitation. It is considered the largest fishery in Latin America. The spawning biomass is estimated to be 5 million tons, with a total quota of 680.000 tons for 2020 for SPRFMO member countries. Chile has the right to 64,56% of that amount, equivalent to 439.000 tons. Orizon S.A. processes close to 27% of the chilean quota, making it the most important player in Chile and in the world.



Clean and Versatile

The Jack Mackerel is a noble and coveted healthy natural resource free of antibiotics, hormones and preservatives, which are requirements for products to be "Food Grade and "Feed Grade".



Great Benefits from a healthy source

Jack Mackerel is a wild and very nutritional fish, containing high quantities of protein, vitamins (especially vitamin D, which is very rare in food) and minerals compared to other animal proteins. It is also an excellent source of omega 3 in comparison with other wild fish. This means it is a great source of fatty acids that help the cardiovascular, respiratory and nervous systems uncton properly and it is good for skin care.
